What Is 'e-mentoring'?

The aim of e-mentoring is to answer the questions of Year 6 pupils, who have been offered a place at Sweyne Park, about anything to do with coming here, as quickly and directly as possible. All questions get answered by Year 7 pupils at the school who went to your own primary school last year. We get asked all sorts of things. For example:

'Will I get much homework?'

'The school is so big. How will I find my way around?'

'What kind of food do they serve in the canteen?'

'I am worried about the older children.'

'Are the teachers nice?'

We want you to be as reassured as possible before you come, so you can ask us anything that is on your mind.

Year 7 pupils, who have been specially trained, will read and reply to your questions.
