Dear Parents/Carers

I am sorry to be writing to you at such an early stage in the new school year. Unfortunately, I have this morning, been notified that a member of staff has tested positive for Covid-19.


In conjunction with advice from Public Health England, given that your child may have come into close contact with that member of staff, we have been told that s/he must self-isolate for a period of 14 days. S/he does not need to be tested unless s/he starts to display Covid-19 related symptoms. Other members of your household do not need to self-isolate themselves unless your son/daughter subsequently develops symptoms, or you display symptoms yourself.

We are awaiting an official letter from Public Health England which will we send to you as soon as possible. In the meantime, if you have any questions, please do contact Public Health England, or go to their website.

I will write to you again very shortly regarding setting work for your son/daughter to do whilst they are self-isolating.

I apologise for the inconvenience this may cause you and your family.
