Administration of students (10am onwards in the Hall)

A2 Results

- Students' A2 results will be released at **8.30am** on Thursday 18 August.
- Students will be administered by staff in two cohorts – UCAS and non-UCAS.

Administration of UCAS students

Scenario	Staff	Location
Student has secured entry to university (either firm or insurance choice)	NSm	Sixth Form Office
Student has secured entry to their insurance choice of university but does not want to accept the offer (i.e. may have to enter Clearing)	JCI	Maslow Library
Student has missed the entry threshold for both their firm or insurance choice of university (i.e. will have to enter Clearing)	ARo	ARo Office
Student is eligible for Adjustment	JCI	Maslow Library
Student has secured entry to university but has now made other plans to enter employment or training	NSm	Sixth Form Office

Administration of non-UCAS students

Scenario	Staff	Location
Student has a firm offer of employment or an apprenticeship, and has met the eligibility requirements	KDi	Library
Student has a firm offer of employment or an apprenticeship, but has not met the eligibility requirements	EHa	Library
Student has changed their mind about employment or an apprenticeship, and would like to make a first approach to university via Clearing	JCI	Sixth Form Office
Student has no firm post-18 plans and needs careers guidance	EHa	Library

Clearing

- The Marie Curie IT Suite and S02 will be available for students who wish to search for vacancies in Clearing. ARo and JCI will advise students who have missed the terms of their offers but still wish to go to university.
- Teaching rooms S03 through S07 will be made available as quiet spaces for students to make telephone calls to individual universities to enquire about course availability.

Enquiries About Results (EAR) Service

- Where a student wishes to challenge an examination grade, they can use the EAR service. This gives students two options:
 1. Students can request to see a copy of their script to see whether it is worth challenging. There is only an 8-day window in which to do this from A Level Results Day, as **the deadline for the Priority Service is Friday 26 August**. This is usually a student's preferred option, but the input of a member of staff is vital in judging whether the student has a strong case.
 2. Students can request a blind re-mark (i.e. without seeing the script first) using the non-Priority Service until Tuesday 20 September. Students may still request to see the original script once a paper has been re-marked, but there is no possibility of a re-mark or a change in grade after this point.
- All requests for re-marks must be made with the input of a member of staff and via the Examinations Officer.
