Year 7 Literacy and Numeracy Catch-up Premium at The Sweyne Park School 2015/16

The literacy and numeracy catch-up premium gives schools additional funding to support year 7 pupils who did not achieve at least level 4 in reading and/or maths at the end of key stage 2 (KS2). There are 17 pupils that are below level 4 in reading and 26 pupils are below level 4 in maths.

During 2015/16 the school is expected to receive approximately £19,000 for the Year 7 catch-up premium (based on 2014/15 allocation). This funding will be used to:

- Enhance additional adult support in lower sets for English and maths lessons (approximately £5,956).
- Provide 1:1 tuition for individual support in literacy and/or numeracy (approximately £5040)
- Set up and running a paired reading scheme (approximately £1000)
- Set up and running a numeracy club, aimed at pupils below level 4 (approximately £1000)
- Support transition from Year 6 to Year 7 (approximately £878)
- Organise a literacy and numeracy summer school (approximately £5050)
- Organise a parent workshop, where parents will learn how they can best support pupils at home (approximately £200)

The intended impact of the above will be for all pupils to reach at least a level 4L in English and maths, by the end of Year 7.
