Year 7 Literacy and Numeracy Catch-up Premium at The Sweyne Park School 2017/18

The literacy and numeracy catch-up premium gives schools additional funding to support year 7 pupils who did not achieve the expected standard in reading or maths at the end of key stage 2 (KS2). There are 73 pupils that are below the expected standard in reading and 62 pupils are below the expected standard in maths.

During 201/17 the school is expected to receive approximately £19,000 for the catch-up premium (based on 2016/2017 allocation). This funding will be used for:

- Enhancing additional adult support in lower sets for English and maths lessons.
- 1:1 tuition for individual support in literacy and/or numeracy.
- Running a paired reading scheme.
- Running a numeracy club, aimed at pupils below the expected standard.
- Supporting transition from Year 6 to Year 7
- Organising a parent workshop, where parents will learn how they can best support pupils at home.

The intended impact of the above will be for all pupils to reach at least the expected standard in English and maths.
