**Year 7 Literacy and Numeracy Catch-up Premium at The Sweyne Park School 2018/19**

The literacy and numeracy catch-up premium gives schools additional funding to support year 7 pupils who did not achieve the expected standard in reading or maths at the end of key stage 2 (KS2). There are 42 pupils that are below the expected standard in reading and 58 pupils are below the expected standard in maths.

During 2018/19 the school is expected to receive approximately £19,587 for the catch-up premium. This funding will be used for:

- Enhancing additional adult support in lower sets for English and maths lessons.
- 1:1 tuition for individual support in literacy and/or numeracy.
- Running a paired reading scheme.
- Running a numeracy club, aimed at pupils below the expected standard.
- Supporting transition from Year 6 to Year 7

The intended impact of the above will be for all pupils to reach at least the expected standard in English and maths.
