**Year 7 Literacy and Numeracy Catch-up Premium at The Sweyne Park School 2019/20**

The literacy and numeracy catch-up premium gives schools additional funding to support year 7 pupils who did not achieve the expected standard in reading or maths at the end of key stage 2 (KS2). There are 68 pupils that are below the expected standard in reading and 62 pupils are below the expected standard in maths.

During 2019/20 the school is expected to receive approximately £19, 000 for the catch-up premium. This funding will be used for:

- 1:1 tuition for individual support in literacy and/or numeracy.
- Running a paired reading scheme run by the Learning Support Department.
- Running a paired reading scheme using Sixth Formers
- Purchasing and running a Times Table Rock Star club. Times Table Rock Star is an online resource, designed to support pupils with multiplication and division skills.

The intended impact of the above will be for all pupils to reach at least the expected standard in reading and maths.
