**The Impact of the Year 7 Literacy and Numeracy Catch-up Premium at The Sweyne Park School 2016/17**

The literacy and numeracy catch-up premium gives schools additional funding to support year 7 pupils who did not achieve the expected standard in reading and/or maths at the end of key stage 2 (KS2). There were 95 pupils that were below the expected standard in reading and 73 pupils were below the expected in maths.

During 2016/17 the school received £19,000 to support these pupils. This funding was used for:

- Enhancing additional adult support in lower sets for English and maths lessons.
- 1:1 tuition for individual support in literacy and/or numeracy.
- Setting up and running a paired reading scheme.
- Supporting transition from Year 6 to Year 7

### **Impact**

The table below, shows the percentage of pupils in the catch-up cohort that made the expected progress by the end of year 7. The three year trend indicates that the significant improvement from 2014-2015, has been sustained over the past two years.
