Students will be in uniform, but the mosque does have a dress code. As a Religious Institution and Centre, users and visitors are kindly asked to observe a modest dress code bearing in mind the following:

- Avoid see-through/opaque, tight-fitting, and low-cut clothing. Sleeves should reach below the elbows.
- Shorts are not allowed
- Skirts and dresses should reach below the knee
- For females Head and chest will need to be covered. Scarves can be provided upon request
- All visitors will be requested to remove their shoes and store them on the shoe racks before we enter the carpeted prayer hall

This trip will be covered by school insurance and accompanied by members of staff. This trip requires us to prepurchase transport/tickets to obtain the best price. Therefore, we will be unable to offer a refund unless there are exceptional circumstances in the event of your child being unable to attend the trip.
